



Deal nine You are +9 (your crib) Jake is -3 Your par is 111


















"Thirty-one" (score two) "Eight"

Summary: once again the starter card assured you of exceeding par 111, allowing you to peg defensively. Jake scored an average 11 points and is 2 points short of winning the game. The crib contained 6 points and your total score for deal nine is 21 points...more

than enough to win the game. Playing defensively, after Jake's high-scoring deal four, has won the game for you. The Cribbage Law of Averages and the "Twenty-six Theory" has rewarded you with another "squeeker" victory!
